### What is Creative Junk?

Creative junk is a not-for-profit community centre. We have a voluntary management committee employing people to run the centre with help from volunteers.

We collect and accept a wide range of cheap and reusable materials to use for creative and imaginative happenings in the community.

Materials are used by children of all ages in early childhood education centres, schools, recreational groups and the community.

Art materials and other equipment are for sale at wholesale prices.

Workshops are held to promote recycle, reuse, rethink and develop and strengthen education profile on and off site.

Our workshop room is available for hire. Workshops, birthday parties, meetings, etc.

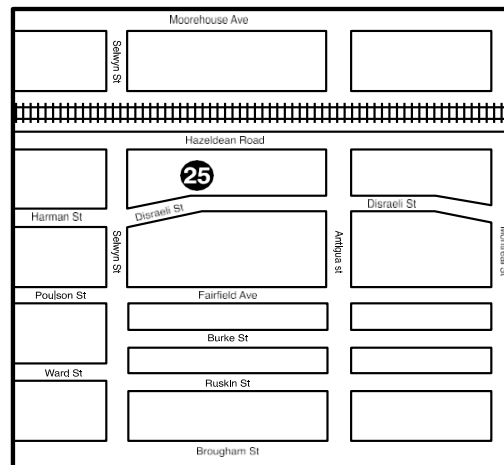
